May 28th, 2020 - the oceans bulge not to scale while both the moon and the sun influence the ocean tides the moon plays the biggest role because the moon is so much closer to our planet than the sun the tidal effect of the moon on earth is more than twice as strong as that of the sun even though the sun s gravitational pull on earth is around 178 times stronger than that of the moon'
